## About Gift Aid

### What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid is a simple scheme that enables charities to reclaim the basic rate of tax on donations received from UK taxpayers. So for every £1 you give, we get an extra 25p from HM Revenue & Customs, helping your donation go further. Imagine the difference that could make, and it doesn't cost you a thing. HMRC will also be operating transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6 April 2008 until 5 April 2011, paying a Government supplement of 3p on every pound you give.

### Do I qualify to give Gift Aid?

Firstly, you need to be a UK taxpayer. Secondly, what you pay in tax in the year through income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount that will be claimed in Gift Aid from you donations in the same year.

### How do I declare I want to give Gift Aid?

Just fill out your details below and send the form to the address at the bottom, or alternatively hand it to a member of staff on site. It really is that simple. So go on, gift aid it!
